1. And David spoke to Hashem the words of this song in the day that Hashem delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul; 2. And he said, Hashem is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; 3. The Elohim of my rock; in him will I trust; he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my savior; you save me from violence. 4. I will call on Hashem, who is worthy to be praised; so shall I be saved from my enemies. 5. When the waves of death surrounded me, the floods of ungodly men made me afraid; 6. The cords of Sheol encircled me; the snares of death confronted me; 7. In my distress I called upon Hashem, and cried to my Elohim; and he heard my voice from his temple, and my cry entered into his ears. 8. Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because of his anger. 9. There went up a smoke from his nostrils, and fire from his mouth devoured; coals were kindled by it. 10. He bowed the heavens also, and came down; and darkness was under his feet. 11. And he rode upon a kerub, and did fly; and he was seen upon the wings of the wind. 12. And he made darkness pavilions around him, the heavy mass of waters, and thick clouds of the skies. 13. Through the brightness before him were coals of fire kindled. 14. Hashem thundered from heaven, and the most High uttered his voice. 15. And he sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and confounded them. 16. And the channels of the sea appeared, the foundations of the world were laid bare, at the rebuking of Hashem, at the blast of the breath of his nostrils. 17. He sent from above, he took me; he drew me out of many waters; 18. He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from those who hated me; for they were too strong for me. 19. They surprised me in the day of my calamity; but Hashem was my stay. 20. He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me. 21. Hashem rewards me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands he recompenses me. 22. For I have kept the ways of Hashem, and have not wickedly departed from my

Elohim. 23. For all his judgments were before me; and as for his statutes, I did not depart from them. 24. I was also upright before him, and have kept myself from my iniquity. 25. Therefore Hashem has recompensed me according to my righteousness; according to my cleanness in his eyesight. 26. With the merciful you will show yourself merciful, and with the upright man you will show yourself upright. 27. With the pure you will show yourself pure; and with the perverse you will show yourself subtle. 28. And the afflicted people you will save; but your eyes are upon the haughty, that you may bring them down. 29. For you are my lamp, O Hashem; and Hashem will lighten my darkness. 30. For by you I run through a troop; by my Elohim I leap over a wall. 31. As for Elohim, his way is perfect; the word of Hashem is tried; he is a shield to all those who trust in him. 32. For who is Elohim, save Hashem? and who is a rock, save our Elohim? 33. Elohim is my strength and rampart; And he makes my way perfect. 34. He makes my feet like hinds' feet; and sets me upon my heights. 35. He teaches my hands to war; and trains my arms to bend a bow of bronze. 36. You have also given me the shield of your salvation; and your condescension has made me great. 37. You have enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip. 38. I have pursued my enemies, and destroyed them; and turned not again until I had consumed them. 39. And I have consumed them, and crushed them, that they could not arise; they are fallen under my feet. 40. For you have girded me with strength to battle; those who rose up against me have you subdued under me. 41. You have also made my enemies turn their backs to me, that I might destroy those who hate me. 42. They looked, but there was none to save; to Hashem, but he answered them not. 43. Then did I beat them as small as the dust of the earth, I did stamp them as the mire of the street, and did spread them abroad. 44. You also have delivered me from strife with of my people, you have kept me to be chief of the nations; a people whom I knew not shall serve me. 45. Strangers shall submit themselves to me; as soon as they hear, they shall be obedient to me. 46. Strangers shall fade away, and they shall come tottering from their closed places. 47. Hashem lives; and blessed be my rock; and exalted is the Elohim of the rock of my salvation. 48. It is Elohim who avenges me, and who brings down the people under me, 49. And who brings me out from my enemies; you also have lifted me up on high above those who rose up against me; you have saved me from the violent man. 50. Therefore I will give thanks to you, O Hashem, among the nations, and I will sing praises to your name. 51. He is the tower of salvation for his king; and shows mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed forever.
