Sing, O barren, you who did not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, you who did not labor with child; for more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, says Hashem. 2. Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of your habitations; spare not, lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes; 3. For you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left; and your seed shall possess nations, and make desolate cities to be inhabited. 4. Fear not; for you shall not be ashamed; neither be confounded; for you shall not be put to shame; for you shall forget the shame of your youth, and shall not remember the reproach of your widowhood any more. 5. For your Maker is your husband; Hashem of hosts is his name; and your redeemer the Holy One of Israel; He is called the Elohim of the earth. 6. For Hashem has called you as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, but a wife of youth, Can she be rejected? says your Elohim. 7. For a small moment have I forsaken you; but with great mercy will I gather you. 8. In overflowing wrath I hid my face from you for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on you, says Hashem your redeemer. 9. For this is like the waters of Noah to me; for just as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be angry with you, nor rebuke you. 10. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall the covenant of my peace be removed, says Hashem who has mercy on you.
